House to house verification by Deputy Commissioner for further enquiry and re-verification of documents

FOR YOUR KNOWLEDGE

- ◆ To ensure inclusion of genuine Indian citizens, certain applications may require further enquiry / Investigation and re-verification by District Magistrates (Deputy Commissioners).
- ◆ In such cases, the Verification Team constituted by the District Magistrates from the NSK will visit the applicants at their residential address.
- ◆ Applicants will get adequate opportunity during these visits to clear any doubt or provide clarification.
- ◆ Re-verification visits to start from 1st December, 2017.
- ◆ During their visit, the Verification Team will inform the applicant in writing about the description of the documents or particulars which need to be re-verified.

YOUR COOPERATION COUNTS

- ◆ Applicants to make themselves available at their residential address during the Verification Teams' visit and cooperate with them.
- ◆ For the purpose of re-verification, applicant may have to show the original document
- ◆ No original document will be taken into custody by the Verification Team.
- ◆ Wholehearted cooperation of public is essential to ensure inclusion of all genuine Indian citizens and exclusion of all ineligible persons or illegal migrants in NRC.

ONLY ONE LIST – NO CATEGORISATION

- ◆ Draft or Final NRC will only list Indian Citizens with no categorisation as 'Original Inhabitants' or otherwise.
- ◆ All genuine Indian Citizens as per date of **24th March, 1971** (midnight), shall be included in the NRC.

GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL

In case of any instance of harassment, visit the concerned NRC Seva Kendra (NSK) to lodge complaint with the Local Registrar of Citizen Registration (LRCR) or with Circle Officer who is the Circle Registrar of Citizen Registration (CRCR) or with Deputy Commissioner, who is the District Registrar of Citizen Registration (DRCR).
