

# NRC UPDATION



## GET READY TO APPLY FOR INCLUSION IN UPDATED NRC

Process of distribution and submission of filled in NRC Application Form has started across the state. The filled-in Application Forms can be submitted in the designated NSKs till 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2015.

Preparatory arrangements to be ensured for easy filling-up of the Application Form for inclusion in updated NRC. Before filling up of the Application Form the family would ensure collection of all details required to be furnished with the Application Form for securing inclusion in the updated NRC.

### There are two requirements for inclusion of names of any person in updated NRC-

- The first requirement is collection of ANY ONE of the following documents of List-A issued up to the midnight of 24<sup>th</sup> March, 1971 where name of self or ancestor\* appears (to prove residence in Assam up to midnight of 24<sup>th</sup> March, 1971).

#### List-A

(1) 1951 NRC OR	(8) LIC OR
(2) Electoral Roll(s) up to 24 <sup>th</sup> March 1971 (midnight) OR	(9) Any Govt. issued License/Certificate OR
(3) Land & Tenancy Records OR	(10) Govt. Service/ Employment Certificate OR
(4) Citizenship Certificate OR	(11) Bank/Post Office Accounts OR
(5) Permanent Residential Certificate OR	(12) Birth Certificate OR
(6) Refugee Registration Certificate OR	(13) Board/University Educational Certificate OR
(7) Passport OR	(14) Court Records/Processes.

Further, two other documents viz (1) Circle Officer/GP Secretary Certificate in respect of married women migrating after marriage (can be of any year before or after 24<sup>th</sup> March (midnight) 1971), and (2) Ration Card issued up to the midnight of 24<sup>th</sup> March, 1971 can be adduced as supporting documents. However, these two documents shall be accepted only if accompanied by any one of the documents listed above.

- The Second requirement is providing linkage / relationship with the name of the ancestor\* appearing in List-A through any legally acceptable document which clearly establishes the relationship claimed between the person and the ancestor\*, as in List-B.

#### List-B

(1) Birth Certificate OR	(5) Circle Officer/GP Secretary Certificate in case of married women OR
(2) Land Document OR	(6) Electoral Roll OR
(3) Board/University Certificate OR	(7) Ration Card OR
(4) Bank/LIC/Post Office Records OR	(8) Any other legally acceptable document

#### Points to remember

- Providing any one of the documents of List-A of ANY PERIOD up to midnight of 24<sup>th</sup> March, 1971 shall be enough to prove eligibility for inclusion in updated NRC. All years preceding 24<sup>th</sup> March (midnight), 1971 are of equal importance. In this context rumour about requirement of documents only of pre-1966 period are baseless.
- NRC 1951 and Electoral Rolls up to 24<sup>th</sup> March (midnight) 1971, collectively termed as Legacy Data, as available, have been published by the Government in NRC Seva Kendras (NSKs) across the state. Free of cost printout of such records bearing Legacy Data Code against each name may be obtained from NSKs. The same can also be accessed through the website of NRC, Assam [www.nrcassam.nic.in](http://www.nrcassam.nic.in).
- Even if one's name is not found in the Legacy Data, Application Forms can still be submitted by quoting particulars of any other admissible document listed from 3 to 14 (List-A).
- Circle Officer/GP Secretary Certificate in respect of married women migrating after marriage is only optional and not mandatory. Married women can also use other valid documents to prove linkage.
- Even if anyone's name, age etc. is wrongly recorded in NRC 1951 or in any of the Electoral Rolls up to 1971, there would be ample scope for citizens to prove their linkage with the correct person during Field Verification. Affidavits if submitted will be received but corrections mentioned therein would be effected only after satisfactory verification of its particulars by verifying officials.
- Documents given in List-B shall be used to prove relationship of the applicant with the person whose name appears in any of the documents in List-A. Documents given in List-B are only for proving relationship/linkage and only supportive in nature. As such, existence of a valid document in List-A shall be a pre-requisite to consider validity of Document from List-B. Any document submitted should be verifiable with the originals available with the issuing authority. This document can be issued on any date and has no reference to the date 24<sup>th</sup> March, 1971.

\* Ancestor can be father or mother or grandfather or grandmother or great grandfather or great grandmother and so on. One can draw linkage from any one of the ancestors listed here.

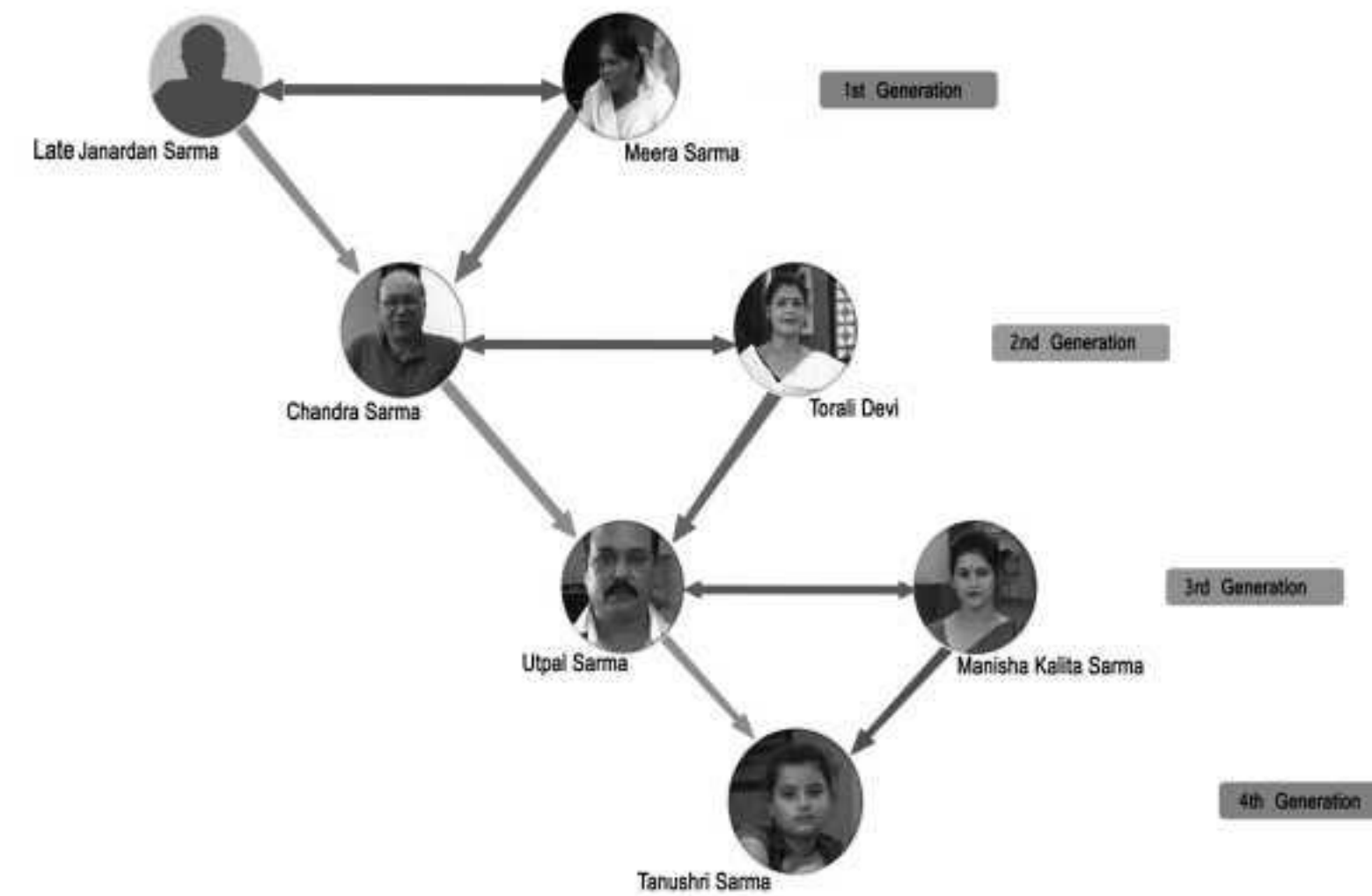

Now let's have an illustration of how a family will collect and arrange documents from List-A and List-B to submit with the Application Form through the family of Shri Chandra Sharma in the next page

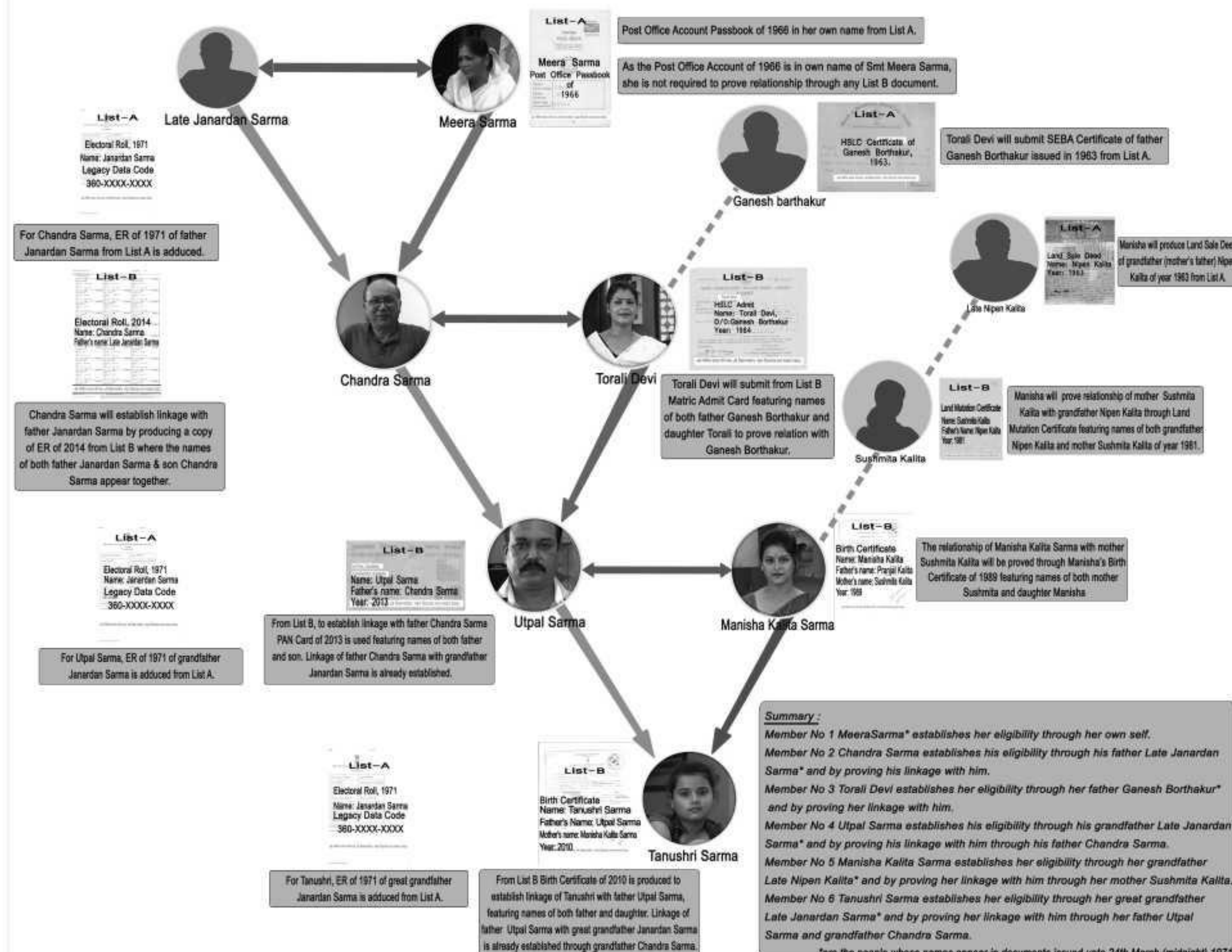

### First, let us have an introduction to the Chandra Sarma family:



### Then, let us see how this family collects and arranges these required documents.



**Summary:**  
 Member No 1 Meera Sarma\* establishes her eligibility through her own self.  
 Member No 2 Chandra Sarma establishes his eligibility through his father Late Janardan Sarma\* and by proving his linkage with him.  
 Member No 3 Torali Devi establishes her eligibility through her father Ganesh Borthakur\* and by proving her linkage with him.  
 Member No 4 Utpal Sarma establishes his eligibility through his grandfather Late Janardan Sarma\* and by proving his linkage with him through his father Chandra Sarma.  
 Member No 5 Manisha Kalita Sarma establishes her eligibility through her grandfather Late Nipen Kalita\* and by proving her linkage with him through her mother Sushmita Kalita.  
 Member No 6 Tanushri Sarma establishes her eligibility through her great grandfather Late Janardan Sarma\* and by proving her linkage with him through her father Utpal Sarma and grandfather Chandra Sarma.  
 \*are the people whose names appear in documents issued upto 24th March (midnight) 1971!

In the illustration presented above we have provided only one of the many ways available to the members to establish their eligibility for inclusion in updated NRC. There are many other ways through which members of this family can prove such eligibility. For example,  
 ✓ Member No 1 Smt Meera Sarma can also adduce any other admissible document from List A.  
 ✓ Member No 2 Shri Chandra Sarma can also draw his linkage through mother Meera Sarma and by proving his relationship with mother Meera through any document (s). In such case, even if any List A document was not available carrying Janardan Sarma's name, the current Electoral Rolls showing names of 1.) Meera as wife of, and 2.) Chandra as son of Janardan could have established Chandra to be the son of Meera Sarma and established his eligibility through her.  
 ✓ Member No 4 Shri Utpal Sarma also has other options. If Utpal's father Chandra Sarma proves eligibility through his mother Meera, Utpal can also draw linkage to grandfather through father. Besides Utpal can establish eligibility through maternal grandfather Ganesh Borthakur by drawing linkage with him through mother Torali Devi.  
 ✓ Member No 6 Tanushri Sarma among various other options can take the same route like her father Utpal and establish eligibility through great grandmother Meera Sarma through father Utpal and grandfather Chandra. Moreover, she can also establish eligibility through maternal great grandfather Nipen Kalita by drawing linkage with him through her mother Manisha Kalita Sarma. Her Birth Certificate may already be having the name of her mother Manisha written on it making her easier to use this route.

In this way, the Chandra Sarma family is now ready to fill up the Application Form for inclusion in updated NRC. Is your family ready with all required documents to fill up the Application Form correctly to secure your family's inclusion in the updated NRC ?
