VERIFICATION UPDATES

- 1. Digitization of Application Forms is going on in full swing and is targeted to be completed within 15th November, 2015. Around 7200 data entry operators deployed for data entry works.
- 2. About 40% documents are getting verified at local level and rest are being sent to other districts/states for verification by way of authenticating with the originals available with issuing authority.
- 3. Sophisticated software developed for sending documents to different destinations electronically to make the mammoth task of verifying approximately 5 crore documents achievable within December, 2015.
- 4. Preparation of Field Verification Kit has completed for Verification Team (VT) consisting of sophisticated software generated reports for easier identification of false claims.
- 5. Field verification has started in the 2nd week of October, 2015 and the first round is slated for completion during the 2nd half of November, 2015.
- 6. Second round will be for cases requiring deeper investigation.
- 7. Family tree of applicants listing the name of Legacy person, and his/ her spouse, children and grandchildren shall be collected from public during the first round of field visit. This method will facilitate comparing of such details with the claims received through applicants across the state. If there is apparent mismatch found in the family tree manually filled up by applicants with the one generated by software on the basis of App Form data, the same can be used by the VT for stringent verification for identification of fake claims by illegal migrants.

VERIFICATION FUNDAMENTALS

Conduct of office verification: Usually authentication of any document is done through matching the photocopy submitted by applicants with originals, like it is done during university admission or job recruitment. But for creation of an error free NRC, this method of verification is not sufficient. Authentication here is to be fool proof. Each of about 5 crore document submitted shall be sent to the issuing authority to ascertain :

- 1. Whether the document was actually issued by that authority or not and,
- 2. Whether the particulars of the document submitted by applicant matches with the particular recorded in the original document of the issuing authority.

OFFICE VERIFICATION WILL IDENTIFY AND ELIMINATE FAKE / FORGED DOCUMENTS

Conduct of field verification:

House to house visits by Verification team to:

- 1. Check identity proof and match photo of applicant
- 2. Compare submitted documents with originals
- 3. Establish if documents submitted relates to the person
- 4. Verify relationship claimed through List-B document
- 5. In case of absence of List-B document, relationship to be ascertained by VT through quasi-judicial process
- 6. Determine correct particulars in case of aliases/ erroneous names in Legacy Data.
- 7. Make corrections (if required) in the Application Form, collect particulars (if any) of unfilled questions in Form
- 8. Collect any additional document
- 9. Collect details of family tree (list of family members) to match the detail with those submitted by the various applicants across Assam. Matching the family tree submitted by applicants with the one generated by software on the basis of Forms received will be the most important mechanism to detect false claims.

ROLE OF PUBLIC

Though verification is a statutory duty to be performed by 8 Report cases of new born babies or deaths in family occurred aff

government machinery, without support and active engagement of public, verification, the most crucial phase of NRC Updation can't truly succeed. We appeal the public to:

- 1. Participate enthusiastically as all did during the Application receipt phase
- 2. Individual members as well as the the civil society to take ownership and vigilantly support the authorities on the process of verification of Forms and documents submitted by the public with great effort.
- 3. Cooperate with the Verification Team. It must be remembered that submitting the Application Form is not enough for inclusion in NRC. It is the result of verification which would ensure the applicant's inclusion in NRC.
- 4. Some applicants have submitted documents which are legally nonadmissible, such as Birth Certificates issued by School Authority etc. In such cases the VT will ask you for alternate documents and/ or evidence. Please provide photocopy of other admissible document.
- 5. There are errors in filling up some questions in the Application Forms, some are also left blank. Cooperate with the Verification Team in correcting and entering such entries. Preferably the Head of the Family or any adult member of the family can sign to authenticate such corrections.
- 6. Keep originals of the documents submitted ready for cross checking by VT.
- 7. Keep other/additional supporting documents ready, in case required for verification.

- 8. Report cases of new born babies or deaths in family occurred after submission of Application Form. Documentary evidence to be produced.
- 9. Fill up Manual Family Tree Form available at NSKs and available for download from website of NRC, Assam (www.nrcassam.nic.in) with details of your family members (Name of Legacy Person and his/her spouse/children and grandchildren). **This is going to be your most crucial contribution towards an accurate NRC.** For example, if the Legacy person is your paternal grandfather/grandmother then provide the list of his/her children viz your father and uncle/aunts and his/her grandchildren viz you, your siblings and cousins. In case the Legacy person is your father/mother, then provide the list of your siblings and your children and nephew/nieces. This list would ensure that no imposter misuses the Legacy Code of your ancestor to find an inclusion in NRC. Wherever possible, also provide the additional Legacy Data Codes available in the name of the Legacy person but not used.
- 10. Report any dereliction of duty by any official.
- 11. Report any instance of use of fraudulent means by any person.
- 12. Report any instance of harassment by verification team.
- 13. Those who missed the visit of Verification Team or are presently out of state, can visit their designated NSK any time before 15th November 2015 to get their claims verified. Those presently residing out of Assam and have applied online can locate their designated NSK through the "Know your NSK" feature in the NRC website.
